ACTIVITIES:

1.

Look at the resource links below about the sculpture, “DANDY” and ask the children to **answer the following questions, gathering the answers on a spider diagram:**

- a) Where is “Dandy”?
- b) What is “Dandy”?
 - c) How big is he?
 - d) How would you describe him?
 - e) What is the story behind him?
 - f) What is he made of?
 - g) What is the name of the artist who made him?
 - h) What do you know about her?

Put the spider diagram is put somewhere where everyone can see it.

2.

Gather together some images that they could use in their leaflets, either photographs or original drawings that they have done.

3.

Individually or in pairs design their leaflets.

They could consider including the following:

The most important things that someone would need to know. (e.g., What / Where?)

The most interesting facts that you think would make someone want to go and see “Dandy.” These could be written in paragraphs or as bullet points.

A description of “Dandy”.

Information about the artist.

How can you make your design attractive and stand out so that people will want to pick it up?

A map of the area showing “Dandy’s” location.
